Think Pharmacy First:

Patients are now able to get treatment for seven common conditions at their high street pharmacy without needing to see a GP as part of a major transformation in the way the NHS delivers care.

The seven conditions are:

Sinusitis; children and adults aged 12 years and over. Sore throats; children and adults aged 5 years and over. Earache; acute otitis media – only for children aged 1-17. Insect bites; infected inset bites – children and adults aged 1 year and over.

Impetigo; children and adults aged 1 year and over. Shingles; adults aged 18 years and over.

UTI's – uncomplicated in women aged 16 to 64 years.
